PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON YOUR DESIGNATED DAY:

1. Your most recent heating bill or verification from your landlord that the heating expenses are included in your rent.
2. Proof of Social Security Number or Permanent Resident card (Green Card) for each member of the household.
3. Proof of your household's (all members) income for the preceding month.
